An `ease-in-out` would typically provide a far superior user experience. General UI Interactions: In most interactive UI elements, a linear transition is often counterintuitive and can feel less intuitive and less engaging than smoother transitions. The abruptness can negatively impact the perceived quality of the interface.
