Precise Timing-Dependent Actions: If a specific action needs to happen at a precise moment within an animation, a linear transition allows you to reliably predict and calculate the timing. This is crucial in situations that require highly synchronized animations.

Despite its advantages, the `linear` transition can feel unnatural and jarring in many applications. Its lack of acceleration or deceleration makes it stand out from the natural physics we observe in the real world. Menu Animations: A linear transition for a menu sliding open or closing can feel robotic and less engaging. A more natural feel is usually achieved with an `ease-in-out` transition, where the animation starts and ends slowly, creating a more graceful movement. An `ease-in-out` would typically provide a far superior user experience. General UI Interactions: In most interactive UI elements, a linear transition is often counterintuitive and can feel less intuitive and less engaging than smoother transitions. The abruptness can negatively impact the perceived quality of the interface.
